

ROCK HARD 4X4 JEEP WRANGLER JK 2/4-DOOR 2007-2017 WINCH PLATE FOR OEM PLASTIC FRONT BUMPER PART #: RH-5010 Installation Manual



PACKING LIST:

- **1- WINCH PLATE**
- 2 ¹/₂" X 13 X 1" GRADE 5 HEX BOLT
- 2 ¹/₂" SAE WASHER
- 2 ¹/₂" LOCK WASHER

REQUIRED TOOLS:

18MM SOCKET 3" EXTENSION 34" SOCKET

REMOVING FACTORY FRONT BUMPER (OPTIONAL AS YOU CAN ALSO SIMPLY LOOSEN FRONT BUMPER)

- 1. Remove upper valence by unscrewing two plastic body plugs. Sometimes it's easier to simply drill them out. Discard.
- 2. Remove lower air dam by unclipping 4 plastic body plugs along front of bumper and 2 along back of air dam. Reinstall is optional.
- 3. Use a 18MM socket and 3" extension to remove 8 nuts on back of front bumper. 4 per frame horn on backside of bumper.
- 4. Unclip factory fog lights harness from passenger side frame rail (if equipped).
- 5. Slide factory front bumper off frame rails to expose remaining factory fog light wiring harness clips. Use wire cutters to cut zip ties, do not cut fog light wires.
- 6. Unclip factory fog lights from housings.
- 7. Remove front bumper from vehicle.

LOOSENING OF FACTORY FRONT BUMPER (FULL REMOVAL NOT NECESSARY)

- 1. Remove upper valence by unscrewing two plastic body plugs. Sometimes it's easier to simply drill them out. Discard.
- Remove lower air dam by unclipping 4 plastic body plugs along front of bumper and 2 along back of air dam. Reinstall is optional.
- 3. Use a 18MM socket and 3" extension to loosen 8 nuts on back of front bumper. 4 per frame horn on backside of bumper.

INSTALLING WINCH PLATE

PRO TIP: INSTALL AND REMOVE BOLTS INTO WINCH PLATE MOUNTING LEGS TO CLEAR OUT EXCESS POWDER COAT.

PRO TIPS: INSTALL WINCH PRIOR TO INSTALLING WINCH PLATE INTO FRAME. INSTALL HOOP (SOLD SEPARATELY) PRIOR TO INSTALLING WINCH PLATE.

- 1. Carefully side winch mount into frame brackets and align holes.
- Install two bolts with lock washers and flat washers using ³/₄" socket. Do not fully tighten at this time.
- 3. Reinstall bumper.
- 4. Align winch plate with tow hooks in bumper, tighten all hardware.
- 5. <u>Stand back and enjoy your new winch plate.</u>
