INSTALL TIP: SOME XJ'S HAVE AN EXTENDED RANGE FUEL TANK. YOU WILL KNOW IF THIS IS THE CASE WHEN YOU ALIGN FUEL TANK SKID PLATE UNDER YOUR CHEROKEE AND OUR REARWARD MOUNTING HOLES DO NOT REACH. IF YOU NEED TO USE OUR MACHINED SPACERS, USE INCLUDED LONGER BOLTS.

- 1. Remove OEM fuel tank shield.
- 2. Using a floor jack for support, position fuel tank skid plate under gas tank.
- 3. Insert 3 bolts with washers though existing holes along rear bumper with threads protruding through bottom. Align skid plate to these bolts.
- 4. Raise fuel skid up and through rear 3 bolts. If skid plate will not reach but front legs are against frame, this is where you would use the 3 longer bolts and included machined spacers along the back to space skid plate down.
- 5. Mark forward mounting holes with a sharpie.
- 6. Lower fuel tank skid plate out of the way. Drill ½" holes. Install nutzerts using supplied tool.
- 7. <u>Reposition skid plate and install using supplied washers</u>. Nylock nuts used along 3 rear bolts with washers on top and bottom of 3 bolts.
