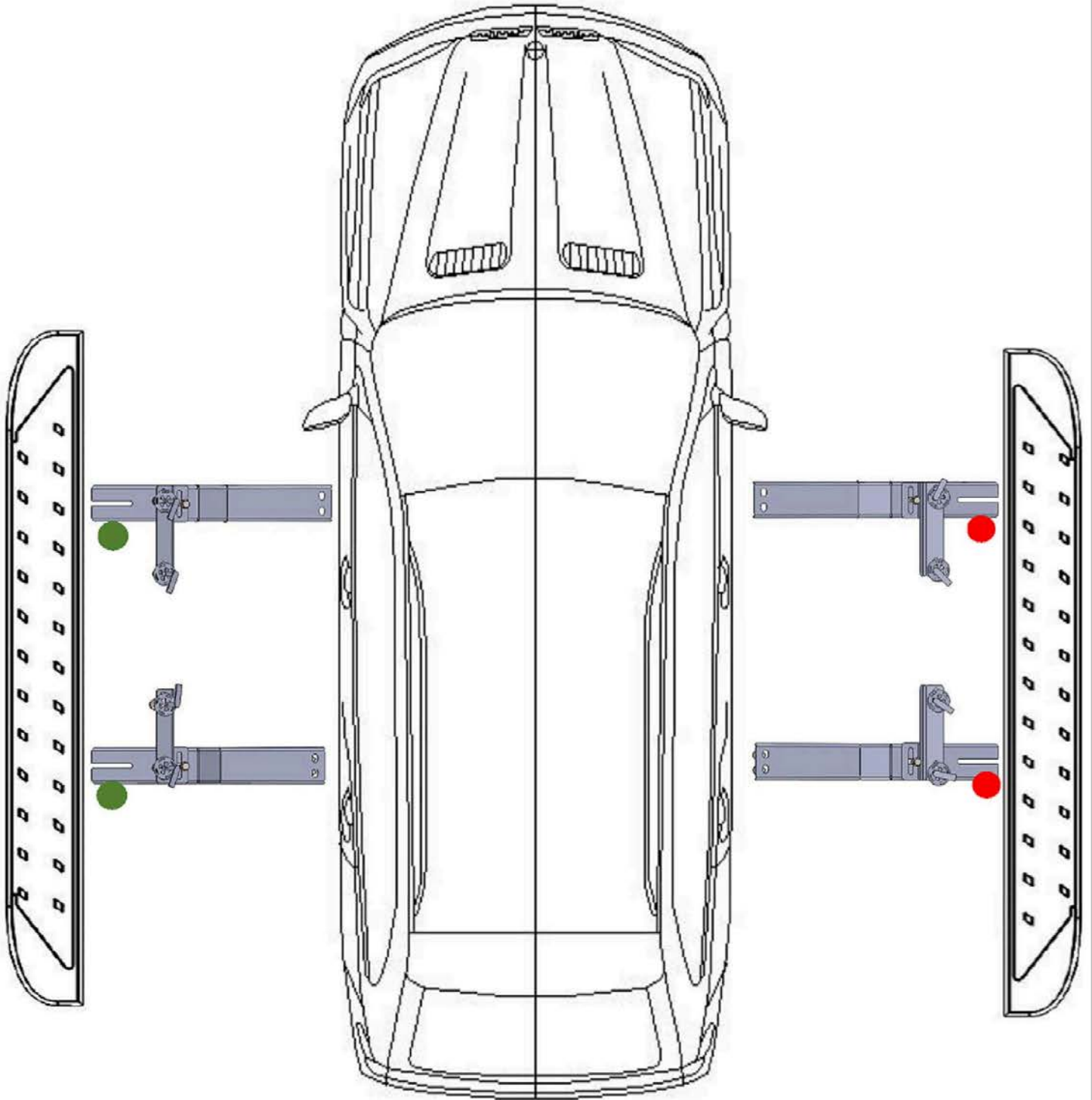


- 1) Locate front bracket mounting area as shown on image #1 remove factory bolts do not discard as they will be reused.
- 2) Attach front bracket using factory bolts image #2 hand tight only
- 3) Locate extra support mounting area and remove factory rubber plugs image #3
- 4) Install supplied HTC 226 with HTC 271 and attach front extra support bracket as shown on images #4 and #5
- 5) Attach extra support bracket to main bracket using supplied M10 hardware hand tight only
- 6) Proceed to rear bracket area



- 1) Locate rear bracket mounting area. Note if your vehicle is equipped with plastic panel it must be either removed or cut to get access to factory bolts image #1
- 2) Remove factory bolts do not discard as they will be re-used image #2
- 3) Attach rear bracket using factory bolts hand tight only image #3
- 4) Locate extra support mounting area and remove rubber plugs
- 5) Install supplied HTC 226 with HTC 271 as shown on image #4
- 6) Attach extra support bracket as shown on image #5 hand tight only
- 7) Connect extra support bracket to rear bracket using supplied M10 hardware
- 8) Loosen M8 hardware on back of steps and install on brackets
- 9) Proceed to tighten bracket hardware M10 to 35 ft lbs and M8 to 18 ft lbs
- 10) Proceed to tighten M8 hardware on back of steps to 18 ft lbs
- 11) Repeat procedure on opposite side
