


## GMC, Ford, Dodge <u>Dual Steering Stabilizer</u> Part # 7220

## Contents:

- 2 7000WS Steering Stabilizers
- 2 Boots & Boot Ties
- 4 140629 Straight Studs
- 1 Large Axle Bracket
- 2 Axle Bracket U-Bolts w/Nuts & Washers
- 2 Straight Tie Rod End Brackets
- 4 Tie Rod End U-Bolts w/Nuts & Washers

## Installation:

- 1. Park the vehicle on flat level ground & set the emergency brake.
- 2. Turn the tires / wheels to a straight forward position.
- 3. Install the new Skyjacker shock boots over the new Skyjacker steering stabilizers & secure with the supplied boot ties.
- 4. Install the new Skyjacker axle bracket on top of the axle using the supplied 3/8" x 3 1/8" x 3 1/2" u-bolts, washers, & nuts.
- 5. Attach the two straight studs to the new axle bracket & mount one end of the new steering stabilizers to each stud & tighten. **Note:** The cylinders may be mounted with shaft end to the tie rod end bracket if preferred.
- 6. Pull the steering stabilizers out 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" out (exactly halfway). **Note:** The center to center eye length will be 19" when the steering stabilizers are halfway out.
- 7. Install the new studs into each eye of the new steering stabilizers & tie rod brackets.
- 8. Mount the new Skyjacker tie rod end brackets using the supplied 5/16" x 1 1/4" x 1 3/4" u-bolts, washers, & nuts.
- Cycle the tires / wheels fully to the left & right to make sure the new steering stabilizers are adjusted properly & that all brackets are secure.
