
- 1. ORIENT THE ROOF PANEL BOX WITH "THIS SIDEUP" LABEL FACING UPWARDS, THEN OPEN.
- 2. UNFOLD THE PROTECTIVE PLASTIC SHEET, LEAVING IT ON THE BOTTOM OF THE ROOF PANEL.
- 3. USE THE OPEN BOX LID AS A PROTECTIVE SURFACE TO ASSEMBLE THE SMARTCAP UPON. (SEE FIGURE 1)
- 4. WORK WITH CAUTION TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGE.









- 1. REMOVE THE LEFT SIDE PANEL FROM ITS PACKAGING AND PROTECTIVE PLASTIC BAG.
- 2. YOU WILL NOTICE ONE END OF THE PANEL IS SLANTED. TO ENSURE IT'S CORRECTLY ORIENTATED, PLACE THE SLANTED END TOWARDS THE AIR-VENT ON THE ROOF PANEL.
- 3. ONCE ORIENTATED CORRECTLY, INSERT THE SIDE PANEL INTO THE ROOF. (SEE FIGURE 2)


#### FIGURE 3

- 4. TO ALLOW GREATER FLEXIBILITY FOR PANEL FITMENT, ONLY HAND TIGHTEN HARDWARE AT THIS STAGE. (SEE FIGURE 3)
- 5. WORK WITH CAUTION TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGE.



HOOK THE SIDE PANEL INTO THE ROOF, CORRECTLY ORIENTATED, SLANTED END OF SIDE PANEL TO FACE THE DIRECTION OF THE ROOF AIR-VENT.










- 1. ONCE THE SMARTCAP IS FULLY ASSEMBLED AND HAND TIGHTENED, PROCEED TO TORQUE THE FRONT AND REAR FLANGE FASTENERS 6.6 FT-LB, 79 IN-LB OR 9 NM.
- 2. PROCEED TO TORQUE THE M6 NYLOC NUTS WHICH WERE PREVIOUSLY HAND FASTENED TO THE ROO F, IN STEPS 2 & 3 (SEEFIGURE 8) 4.4 FT-LB, 53 IN-LB OR 6 NM.







- 1. ONCE ALL HARDWARE IS TIGHTENED SUFFICIENTLY, PROCEED TO APPLY THE BOTTOM D RUBBER / WEATHER STRIP.
- 2. REMOVE THE BACKING TAPE ON THE ADHESIVE STRIP SLOWLY AS YOU BOND THE RUBBER DOWN CAREFULLY.



3. APPLY THE D - RUBBER, STARTING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE REAR FLANGE. (SEE FIGURE 9, ON PAGE 12)










- 1. SOME TRUCK BEDS MAY HAVE HEIGHT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE SIDES AND FRONT OF THE TRUCK BED. IF THAT IS THE CASE WITH YOUR TRUCK BED, APPLY A FOAM STRIP TO THE LIP OF THE FRONT PANEL.
- 2. REMOVE THE ADHESIVE BACKING TAPE FROM THE FOAM STRIP. (SEE FIGURE 1 & 2)
- 3. APPLY FOAM STRIP ON THE FRONT LIP OF THE PICK UP BOX TO ACCOUNT FOR ANY HEIGHT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE PICKUP BOX SIDES AND THE FRONT PICKUP BOX PANEL. (SEE FIGURE 2)
- 4. CUT TO LENGTH (SEE FIGURE 3)






- 1. A MINIMUM OF FOUR PEOPLE ARE RECOMMENDED TO PICK UP AND PLACE THE SMARTCAP ONTO THE TRUCK.
- 2. TO KEEP FROM DAMAGING YOUR D-RUBBER DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS, IT IS IMPORTANT YOU LIFT THE SMARTCAP IN PLACE AND DO NOT DRAG IT ACROSS THE TRUCK BED RAILS.
- 3. ONCE THE SMARTCAP IS CENTERED, PLACE CLAMPS IN POSITION. (SEE FIGURE 3)
- 4. PLACE THE SUPPLIED THIN RUBBER PAD ON THE SIDE PANEL TO PREVENT CLAMP FROM SCRATCHING THE PAINT.
- 5. PLACE THE 10MM RUBBER PAD UNDER THE SIDE PANEL, BETWEEN THE PICKUP BOX AND THE SMARTCAP, DIRECTLY UNDER THE POSITION YOU INTEND TO INSTALL THE C CLAMP. (SEE FIGURE 4)
- 6. PLACE 3 RUBBER PADS INLINE WITH CLAMPS ON THE BIN LINING, 4TH PAD TO BE PLACED AS A SPACER TOWARDS THE REAR OF THE BIN (SEE FIGURE 4.1), PROCEED TO SUFFICIENTLY TORQUE THE CLAMPS TO 9 FT-LB, 108 IN-LB OR 12.2 NM.








- 1. A MINIMUM OF FOUR PEOPLE ARE RECOMMENDED TO PICK UP AND PLACE THE SMARTCAP ONTO THE TRUCK.
- 2. TO KEEP FROM DAMAGING YOUR D-RUBBER DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS, IT IS IMPORTANT YOU LIFT THE SMARTCAP IN PLACE AND DO NOT DRAG IT ACROSS THE TRUCK BED RAILS.
- 3. ONCE THE SMART CAP IS CENTERED, SLIDE THE BOTTOM HALF OF THE CLAMP INTO THE SLIDE RAILS OF THE TRUCK BED. (SEE FIGURE 3)





- 1. POSITION THE FRONT MOUNT BRACKET IN THE FRONT LEFT HAND CORNER OF THE LOAD BIN.
- 2. USE ONE M6/M8 SET SCREW, WITH M6/M8 SPRING WASHER AND M6/M8 FENDER WASHER TO LOOSELY SCREW THE BRACKET TO THE FRONT OF THE LOAD BIN.
- 3. USE FOUR M8 X 25 SET SCREWS WITH FOUR M8 SPRING WASHERS AND M8 X 25 FENDER WASHERS TO FASTEN THE BRACKET TO THE SIDE OF THE LOAD BIN








- 2. USE FOUR M8 X 25 SET SCREWS WITH EIGHT M8 X 25 FENDER WASHERS AND FOUR M8 NYLOC NUTS TO LOOSELY FASTEN SMARTCAP TO THE REAR MOUNT BRACKETS.
- 3. ONCE ALL THE SET SCREWS ARE IN THEIR CORRECT POSITIONS, FASTEN TO 12NM OR 8.9 FT-LBS.



WITHOUT DISCONNECTING THE TAILLIGHT, REMOVE THE DRIVER'S SIDE TAILLIGHT

- LOCATE THE FACTORY 7-WAY CONNECTOR ATTACHED TO EITHER THE BUMPER OR HITCH.
- REMOVE THE PLUG FROM THE BACK OF THE FACTORY 7-WAY CONNECTOR.

  REFER TO [T3] AND PICTURE (B)



• INSERT THE SUPPLIED T-HARNESS BETWEEN THE FACTORY PLUG AND THE FACTORY
7-WAY CONNECTOR. BE SURE THAT BOTH ENDS OF THE T-HARNESS ARE FULLY INSERTED
WITH THE LOCKING TABS IN PLACE. REFER TO PICTURE (C)



• ROUTE THE 2 PIN PLUG ON THE T-HARNESS ALONG THE BACK SIDE OF THE REAR BUMPER TOWARDS THE DRIVER'S SIDE TAILLIGHT, REFER TO PICTURE (D)



• LOCATE THE CABLE CHASE THAT THE TAILLIGHT WIRING IS RUNNING THROUGH AND ROUTE
THE 2 PIN PLUG FROM THE T-HARNESS INTO THE TAILLIGHT CAVITY. REFER TO PICTURE (E)



• PULL THE WIRE HARNESS THROUGH THE CABLE CHASE UP TO THE BLACK BOX ON THE WIRE HARNESS. REFER TO PICTURE (F)



• FROM YOUR SMARTCAP, ROUTE THE THIRD BRAKE LIGHT 2-PIN PLUG THROUGH THE TRUCK'S REAR BED POST AND INTO THE TAILLIGHT CAVITY.



• CONNECT THE 2-PIN PLUG FROM THE T-HARNESS TO THE SMARTCAP'S THIRD BRAKE LIGHT 2-PIN CONNECTOR.

REINSTALL THE DRIVER'S SIDE TAILLIGHT ASSEMBLY. REFER TO PICTURE (G)



• START YOUR TRUCK. PLEASE NOTE, ON SOME TRUCKS IT MAY TAKE 30 SECONDS FOR THE VEHICLE TO DETECT THE CONNECTION. TEST THE BRAKE LIGHTS AND TURN SIGNALS. CHECK TO MAKE SURE PROPER TURN SIGNAL FUNCTIONALITY WHEN THE BRAKE LIGHTS ARE ON.



• ONCE YOU ARE SURE EVERYTHING IS FUNCTIONING CORRECTLY, SECURE THE CONTROL
BOX AND THE WIRING HARNESS BEHIND THE REAR BUMPER USING ZIP TIES. BE SURE THAT
THE WIRING HARNESS DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH ANY MOVING PARTS OF THE VEHICLE.

After the installation of the wiring harness on some vehicles you might get an error for a disconnected trailer. If this error occurs and your vehicle is equipped with vehicle towing software, navigate in the software and manually enable power to the 7-way. This might appear as "enable auxiliary" or "enable trailer". If CHMSL does not work, shut engine off. Wait 10 seconds and restart engine. Wait an additional 10 seconds for the vehicle to detect CHMSL.

• WITHOUT DISCONNECTING THE TAILLIGHT, REMOVE THE DRIVER' S SIDE TAILLIGHT

• LOCATE THE TOW VEHICLE'S TRAILER HARNESS PLUG. THIS HARNESS IS LOCATED UNDER THE VEHICLE, BEHIND THE BUMPER, ON THE DRIVER'S SIDE OF THE TRUCK.

 REMOVE THE PROTECTIVE CAP FROM THE PLUG AND SAVE. CHECK TO SEE THAT THE MATING SURFACE OF THE HOUSING IS FREE OF DIRT AND CLEAN IF NECESSARY.



- INSERT THE T-CONNECTOR INTO THE VEHICLE'S PLUG. BE SURE THAT THE T-CONNECTOR IS FULLY INSERTED WITH LOCKING TABS IN PLACE.
- PLACE PROTECTIVE CAP ON THE REMAINING PLUG END.

• REMOVE THE LEFT HAND SIDE TAILLIGHT ASSEMBLY, REVEALING THE CAVITY BEHIND THE TAILLIGHT. REFER TO PICTURE [A]



•LOCATE THIRD BRAKE LIGHT 2-PIN PLUG HANGING OFF THE SMARTCAP ON THE LEFT HAND SIDE NEAR THE TAILGATE AND CONNECT THE T-HARNESS TO IT. **REFER TO PICTURE (B)** 



•INSERT THE SUPPLIED T-HARNESS BETWEEN THE FACTORY PLUG AND THE FACTORY 7-WAY CONNECTOR. BE SURE THAT BOTH ENDS OF THE T-HARNESS ARE FULLY INSERTED WITH THE LOCKING TABS IN PLACE. REFER TO PICTURE [C1,2,3 & 4]



• DISCONNECT THE BRAKE LIGHT CABLE (MALE END) FROM THE TAILLIGHT ASSEMBLY AND CONNECT IT TO THE T-HARNESS (FEMALE CONNECTOR). THEN CONNECT THE T-HARNESS (MALE END) TO THE TAILLIGHT ASSEMBLY. REFER TO PICTURE (D)



•TEST THE BRAKE LIGHTS AND TURN SIGNALS. CHECK TO MAKE SURE PROPER TURN SIGNAL FUNCTIONALITY WHEN THE BRAKE LIGHTS ARE ON.



•ONCE YOU ARE SURE EVERYTHING IS FUNCTIONING CORRECTLY, RE-INSTALL THE TAILLIGHT ASSEMBLY.



• THERE WILL BE EXCESS CABLE UNDER YOUR VEHICLE THAT YOU SHOULD SECURE USING A ZIP-TIE.

#### SmartCap EVO|EVOc Troubleshooting Guide

- 1) The rear door is not closing properly or closing is very difficult.
  - a) The mounting clamps have been overtightened. Ensure C-Clamp torque settings have been followed according to the Fitment Instructions and adjust where necessary.
  - b) The 10mm rubber spacers have not been inserted or positioned correctly during fitment to prevent overtightening.
  - c) The main D-Rubber (Weather Strip) is getting in the way because it has not been trimmed correctly as per the assembly instructions.
  - d) The rear door bubble rubber is getting in the way and has possibly come apart from the rear door lip.
- 2) The rear flange and door is not level (Higher/Lower on one end).
  - a) The mounting clamps have not been tightened evenly. Ensure C-Clamp torque settings have been followed according to the Fitment Instructions and adjust slightly where necessary.
  - b) The 10mm rubber pad spacers have not been inserted or positioned correctly during fitment.
- 3) There is a gap between the rear door rubber and the top of the tailgate.
  - a) The mounting clamps have not been tightened enough. Ensure C-Clamp torque settings have been followed according to the Fitment Instructions and adjust slightly where necessary.
  - b) The 10mm rubber spacers have not been inserted or positioned correctly during fitment.
- 4) The doors are not closing flush with the side panels or the rear flange.
  - a) The pressure lock levers need adjusting. This is recommended at least every months for Contractor Use and every 6 months for Leisure usage.
- 5) The rear door High-Level Brake light is not working.
  - a) Ensure that the plug connectors of the supplied wiring harness are connected properly and that the plug terminals have been configured correctly (Positive to positive etc..).
- 6) There is Dust and/or Water in the truck bed.

When a SmartCap EVO is properly assembled and installed, it will be water-tight. Unfortunately, we can't say the same about truck beds. In most cases, when water is leaking in through the truck bed it is coming in due to uneven surfaces between the bulkhead (front panel) and the sides of the bed. To combat this, we provide a foam strip for you to apply to fill the gap created by the height differences. Water can also penetrate a truck bed if there are gaps in the corners where the truck bed side and bulkhead rails come together. Should you encounter this issue, we recommend you use Butyl Tape to fill those gaps.

Here are a few things that can be checked to resolve this:

- a) Ensure that the D-Rubber (Weather Strip) is installed correctly between the bottom of the cap and the top of the bed rail.
- b) Ensure that Butyl Tape has been applied to the front bed rail where necessary.
- c) Ensure that the drain holes for the sliding windows are open.
- d) Check the ends of the D-Rubber (Weather Strip) at the rear corners of the Cap and ensure that they are cut and glued according to the assembly instructions.
