2. Remove the (6) clips



3. Remove the (4) 10mm bolts



4. Remove the phillips head screw



5. Remove the (10) plastic clips



6. Remove the plastic cover



7. Remove the front bumper



8. Cut out fog light hole



9. Remove the fog light hole cutout



10. Install the fog light outer bracket. (the (2) 10mm bolts)



11. Install the fog light outer bracket the (2) 10mm bolts



12. Secure the fog light onto the braketry. ((4) phillips head screws)



13. Remove the plastic clip from the hood latch cover



14. Remove the hood latch cover



15. Remove the (2) plastic clips from the air duct cover



16. Remove the air duct cover




17. Run the fog light harness though the front bulkhead along the factory harness



18. Remove the 10mm bolt front hood latch



19. Secure the fog light harness ground cable, and tighten the 10 mm bolt




20. Zip tie the fog light harness to the factory harness

22. Remove the fusebox undercover




23. Remove the (14) pin connector



24. Remove the (20) pin connector




25. Remove the clip from the (14) pin connector



26 Place the thinner red and white wire into the (14) pin connector, lock clip



27. Remove the clip from the 20 pin connector



28. Place the thicker red wire in the 20 pin connector, lock clip



29. Reattach the connectors to the fusebox

32. Replace the fuse box and tighten the (2) 10mm bolts



33. Loosen the 10mm bolt from the airbox



34. Slide the fog light harness under the airbox

38. Replace the hood latch cover



39. Replace the air duct cover, (2 clips)



40. Connect the fog lights to the harness

44. Replace the phillips head screw



45. Replace the (6) plastic clips



46. Open the fuse box



47. Place the 20 amp fuse in the slot 10



48. Replace the fuse box cover



49. Tighten the (4) 10mm bolts

54. Unclip the switch hole cover
