1. Remove the (2) phillips head screws



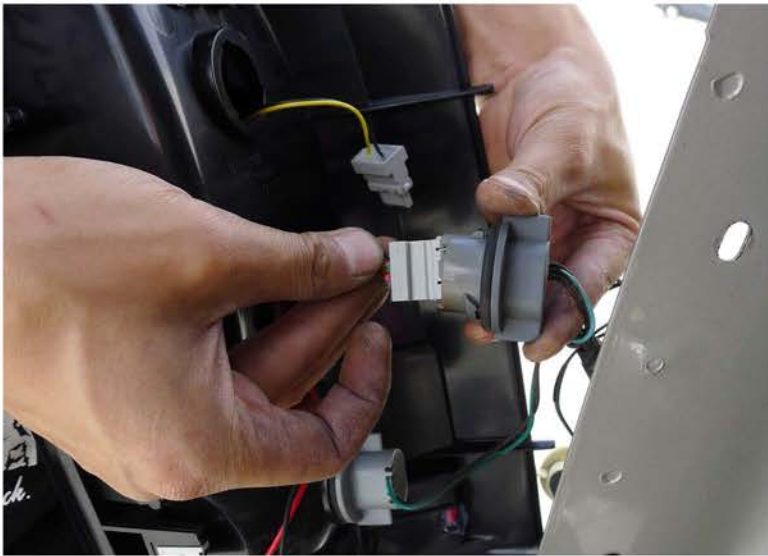
2. Remove the tail light



3. Remove the tail light sockets from the tail light

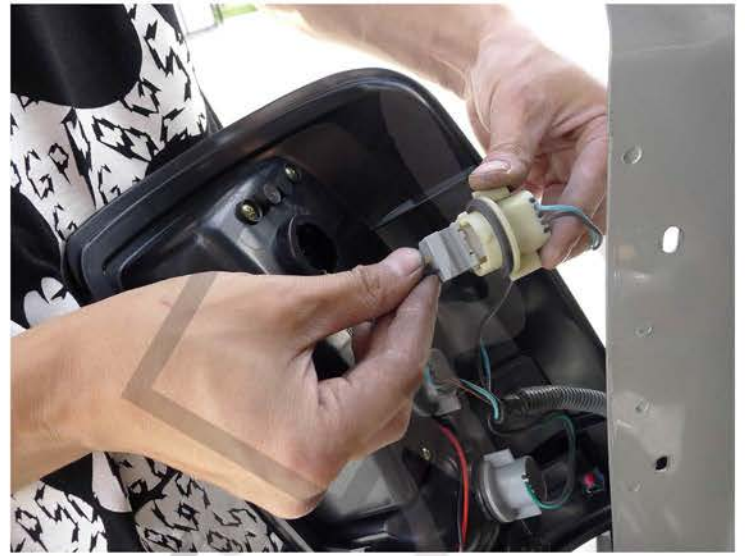


4. Remove the brake light bulbs



6. Connect the LED tail light to the tail light harness

Please see the " L.E.D. tail lights installation instructions"  
If your tail lights don't have L.E.D. you can skip the installation instructions.



6. Connect the LED tail light to the tail light harness



7. Place the tail light socket into the LED tail light



8. Place the LED tail light in the stock location and tighten the (2) phillips head screws



9. Please repeat the steps in order from 1 to 8 for the opposite side. The installation is now complete.
