

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Stillen Intercooler Ducting Upgrade 90-96 300ZX TT P/N 105020

## Materials supplied:

- 1. Intercooler ducts, left and right
- 2. 4@ Bolts (M8x1.25x12mm Flange head bolt)

## Equipment needed:

- 1. Assorted sockets and wrenches
- 2. +,- Screwdriver
- 3. Assorted pliers
- 4. 3/8" diameter drill bit and drill
- 5. Factory service manual

## Installation:

- 1) Preparation
  - a) Cover fenders and other painted surfaces.
  - b) Mark all removed parts for proper re-installation in their original locations.
  - c) Plug all ports or passages to prevent contamination.
  - d) All references to vehicle are from the driver's seat
    - i) Left = driver's left
    - ii) Right = driver's right
- 2) Remove front bumper cover
  - a) Disconnect negative battery terminal
  - b) Raise front of vehicle and put on jack stands. If possible, lifting vehicle on a lift is preferable.
  - c) Following instructions from the factory service manual, remove the:
    - i) Front cover panel.
    - ii) Engine under cover and retainer.
    - iii) Front bumper cover.
- 3) Modify aluminum intercooler support bracket
  - a) Cut 1/8" from edge of aluminum bracket. See photo. Cut edge should be even to edge of gold cad washers.

- 4) Locate and drill mounting holes in urethane ducts.
  - a) Locate taped holes in Stillen Intercooler and transfer to I/C duct. Drill 4 X 3/8" diameter holes in each duct.
  - b) Peel off foam from outside edge of stock inter-cooler duct and apply to outside edge of new duct.
- 5) Install Stillen Intercooler and duct assembly onto vehicle.
- 6) Mock up front bumper
  - a) Install turn signal and turn the lamp socket so it sits inside the small hole provided in duct. It may be necessary to trim duct in some vehicles.
- 7) Install the front bumper cover in the reverse order of disassembly.
  - a) Use the appropriate fasteners for the given application.
    - i) Take care not to install a sheet metal screw into a threaded hole intended for a fine thread screw and vice versa.
    - ii) Start vehicle and check for leaks.
      - (1) You can use a mild soap solution sprayed onto all fitting and hose connections to check for leaks.



## 8) **DONE!**

The diagram shows how the front bumper cover is attached to the vehicle. The factory service manual also indicates the appropriate tightening torque for all body fasteners.
