

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS CAT-BACK EXHAUST P/N 508196 2011 NISSAN JUKE

Materials supplied:

- 1. (1) CAT-BACK EXHAUST
- 2. (2) HHCS Long M10x1.25
- 3. (2) HHCS Short M10x1.25
- 4. (2) M10 Washers
- 5. (4) M10x1.25 Nuts
- 6. (1) 2.25" Muffler Clamp

7. (1) Gasket

- Tools/Materials required:
- 1. Assorted sockets and wrenches
- 2. Spray lubricant

Installation:

1. Begin by raising the rear of the vehicle and supporting it on jack stands.

<u>CAUTION: Never work under a vehicle</u> <u>supported with a jack only!</u>

NOTE: Before unbolting the OEM system, check the tips for alignment. If the factory system is not aligned correctly, then the new system may also be misaligned when complete.

- 2. Spray all the hangers and nuts with penetrating lubricant.
- 3. Unbolt the muffler flange. See (Photo1 & Photo 2)
- 4. Remove the exhaust muffler.
- 5. Transfer the hangers from the OEM muffler to the STILLEN muffler. See (Photo 1& Photo 2)





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- 6. Spray penetrating lubricant on the front nuts ad hangers.
- 7. Unbolt the front end of the mid-pipe. See (Photo 3)
- 8. Remove the stock mid-pipe carefully and set aside. You will be reusing the springs.
- 9. Reinstall your new mid-pipe as previously removed.
- Use the supplied muffler clamp to clamp the 2 sections together. Using the longer bolts and washers you will reuse the springs you set aside earlier from the front end of the mid-pipe. You will be using 2 nuts to secure the long bolts. They will be installed behind the existing welded nuts behind the catalytic converter. See (Photo 4) Tighten down until the threads stop on the bolt. It should be a snug fit.
- 11. Install your new muffler using the provided shorter M10 bolts and nuts. (Photo 5)
- 12. Done!! Enjoy your new STILLEN Cat-Back Exhaust.
- 13. Start vehicle and check for leaks.
