- 1. Temporarily install the Street Scene Rear Valance and note areas that lay against the body. These are the areas that you will apply the double sided tape. Before you allow the double sided tape to contact the body make sure that all area's are clean. NOTE: Installation of the rear valance requires the help of another person or the use of well placed c-clamps to hold the valance in place.
- 2. The rear valance wraps into each rear wheel well and has a lip flange that mates onto the rear doorsill.
- **3.** Double-sided tape is applied along the side of the rear valance and along the rear lip flange. Drill and install 2 rivets in each fender well and several equally spaced rivets along the rear doorsill ensuring that they are not readily seen with the doors closed.
- **4.** Paint to match making sure to follow the urethane painting procedure.
