Installation Guide

ALWAYS SUPPORT THE VEHICLE ON SAFETY STANDS.

- 1. Raise vehicle on lifting platform.
- 2. Remove front wheel.
- 3. Disconnect the air shock ADS electric cable connector. (Located in fender well).



4. Disconnect the sway bar arm linkage,



5. Remove the lower shock mounting nut and bolt.



6. Remove the ball joint nut and separate from the upper control arm.

7. Remove the wire harness mount from shock.



8. Disconnect the air line from top of strut.



9. Remove the air line fitting. To do this, remove the collet and the remaining fitting will slide off of the air hose.



10. Remove the three (3) top flange nuts. Remove strut from vehicle.

Air Spring Removal



11. Top on center cap to gain access to metal C-clip. Use flat head screwdriver to remove clip from top retaining groove.



12. Use chanel lock or pliers to remove center cap. Pull towards you to release.



- 13. Remove top retaining nut and air spring. Remove round and flat rubber rubber o-rings.
- 14. Slide air spring off of shock.



ALWAYS SUPPORT THE VEHICLE ON SAFETY STANDS.



15. Install flat rubber ring then round o-ring down the shock. Lubricate new rubber. Slide new air spring over the shock.



16. Torque retaining nut.



17. Install new rubber o-ring in groove of center cap. Lubricate o-ring.





18. Install center cap. Use mallet to seal cop in order to install metal c-clip.

- 19. Install new air fitting.
- 20. Install in reverse order.
- 21. Once installed, reconnect air line by pushing it in to new fitting.
