

- 1. Disconnect battery ground cable.
- 2. Raise and support vehicle.




- 3. Remove cover from compressor assembly.
- 4. Disconnect air lines and electrical connectors from air compressor. See: Air Line\Service and Repair Page 2.
- 5. Remove compressor assembly mounting screws, then the compressor assembly.
- 6. Remove mounting bracket screws, then slide mounting bracket away from compressor.
- 7. Reverse procedure to install, noting the following:
- a. Torque compressor mounting bracket screws to 70 lb-in.
- b. Torque compressor assembly mounting screws to 70 lb-in.
- c. Torque compressor cover mounting screws to 40 lb-in.
- d. Check system operation.


NOTE: Disconnect battery ground cable before raising vehicle.

Releasing Air Line



1. To release an air line from fitting, pull back on plastic ring, then remove line from fitting.

Attaching Air Line



2. Air line fittings have a push-in feature. A brass type Colette locks the air line in place.

One rubber O-ring seals the air line to prevent leakage. To attach air line, push into fitting.
