Removal

1. Hold the shock absorber stem and remove the upper front shock absorber nut, and washer assembly.


2. WARNING: The electrical power to the air suspension system must be shut off prior to hoisting, jacking or towing an air suspension vehicle. This can be accomplished by turning off the air suspension switch located in the RH kick panel area. Failure to do so can result in unexpected inflation or deflation of the air springs, which can result in shifting of the vehicle during these operations. Raise and support the vehicle.


3. Remove the shock absorber.


- A) Remove the lower nut and bolt.
