GRILLE REMOVAL & GRILLE INSTALLATION GUIDE

START HERE

PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION. Auto makers offer varied models to each vehicle and occasionally manufacture more than one body style of the same model.

* APPLICATION MODELS VARY. WE RECOMMEND TO VERIFY FITMENT BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION PROCESS.
* IMAGES FEATURED IN THE INSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS MAY NOT ALWAYS EXACTLY MATCH YOUR GRILL.

STEP 1 FRONT BUMPER REMOVAL

1) Turn off engine and chalk tires with stop block. Open Hood. Disconnect Battery.

PRO TIP

Before you begin, use "3M Painters Tape" to apply a protective guard around the work areas. Attend to the fender and bumper valance. This will help protect the paint and finish of your vehicle.

STEP 2

2) Begin by removing all of the hardware that secures the factory grille to the vehicle core support.

There should be the (3) 10 MM bolts across the top near the front grille shell.




TOOLS REQUIRED

- Drill
- 1/8" Drill Bit
- Screwdriver set (Phillips)
- Needle Nose Pliers
- Socket Set
- Ratchet Tool
- 1/2" Plastic Spatula

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STEP 3

3) With the hardware removed the factory grille overlay is now ready to be un-installed off the vehicle.

Using both hands, grab the very bottom corners of each side and firmly pull on both sides. This action will pull loose the clips at bottom of grill and release the grille from the grille mounts. The Grille should now be free to pull away from truck.

4) Flip the grille assembly over and place on a flat cushioned surface or foam pad to begin disassembly.

5) It is now time to remove the radiator induction shroud.

Remove all the plastic push tabs that secures the shroud and set asides for later.



6) It is now time cut into the factory grille honeycomb pattern and separate the factory grille shell to re-purpose and utilize with your new T-REX Grille.

7) Using a 90 degree cutoff wheel, zip saw, sawzall or something similar, cut along the presented red line.

8) At this point, check over your work and make certain your cut reflects the images presented here.

STEP 9

9) For those that do want to feature the Chevrolet Bow Tie Badge, you will need to first remove it from the factory grille. Flip it face down to access the tabs that secures the badging. From the back side, use a flat head screw driver to pry the tabs free and pop loose the badge. From the front side pull free from the factory grille.


STEP 10

10) Position the bow tie badge and put into place over the new T-REX grille.

11) Your new T-REX Grille will have locating cutouts to accept the bow tie badge.

12) With the grille face down and the badge put into place, firmly press down and insert the provided clips onto the badge's tabs.

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STEP 13

13) It is now time to mate the grille to the factory shell piece. This is the most critical step of the installation. It is advised to have a friend or helper hold the individual parts.

14) Carefully align the t-rex grille so that it sits evenly aligned with the shell.




SEE FIGURES 18 - 19 15) With your grille alignment placed and finalized, use the T-Rex Grilles mounting tabs to determine your drill holes.

16) Using the provided screws, fasten and secure the T-Rex Grille to the factory shell





18) Using a wrench or nut driver, tighten the (6) provided 10 mm nuts down to secure the lower mounting plate to the new T-Rex Grille.

19) Double check your work and make sure everything is good and tight.


20) Take the radiator induction shroud that was set aside earlier and align it over your new T-Rex Grille assembly.

21) Line up the tabs and set it down in place.


22) Using the T-Rex provided push clips, firmly press them down so that they latch onto the lower mounting plate and secures the radiator induction shroud.

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STEP 23

23) Remove all the fastener clips from the factory grille that was cut off from the shell.

STEP 24

24) Re-use the grille mounting fastener clips and place them along the larger higher post tabs. Press them down so they sit securely on the tabs.

25) Re-using the plastic push tabs that were set aside during the grille disassembly, re-insert them into their mounting points which will fully secure the radiator induction shroud to the factory grille shell and complete T-Rex grille assembly .

GRILLE INSTALL - START

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STEPS 26 & 27

- 26) Check over your work for hardware tightness and visual inspection.
- 27) Re-install the grille assembly in the reverse order that it was removed from the vehicle.

STEP 28 SEE FIGURES 36 & 37

28) At this point you want to look over your work and examine the gap alignments around all edges and in between the new T-REX Grille and the vehicle components and body lines. Carefully close the hood for a complete visual inspection. If adjustment is needed, you can remove grille and loosen the hardware mounts and shift side to side or up & down to achieve proper look.
