Important information that needs to be read before installation begins:

Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension packages (2) sets of instruction sheets with this box kit. (1) is for the installer and (1) is for the customer. The (1) for the customer has some post installation procedure literature and it is the installers responsibility to make sure that the customer receives a copy of the installation manual along with the literature.

Before installation begins, Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension highly recommends that the installer performs a test drive on the vehicle. During the test drive, check to see if there are any uncommon sounds or vibrations. If uncommon sounds or vibrations occur on the test drive, uncommon sounds or vibrations will be enhanced once the suspension system has been installed. Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension highly recommends notifying the customer prior to installation to inform the customer of these issues if they exist.

Make sure to use thread locker or loctite on all new and stock hardware associated with the installation of this suspension system.

Special note: Before installation begins, it is the customers/installers responsibility to make sure that all parts are on hand.


Please follow instructions carefully:

1. To begin installation, carefully block the front tires and wheels so that the vehicle can not roll forward. Safely lift the rear of the vehicle and support the vehicle with a pair of jack stands. Place a jack stand on both the driver and the passenger side.


Place a pair of hydraulic floor jacks under the rear axle. Place on on the driver side and one on the passenger side. Carefully raise up on the hydraulic floor jacks until they make contact with the rear axle.

front legs of the u-bolts. Save the hardware. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.

Locate the new rear ladder bar brackets. Working on the driver side, install the new bracket to the front legs of the ubolts and secure using the hardware that was removed earlier. Torque to 125 ft lbs. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



Locate the front driver side ladder bar bracket. Place the ladder bar bracket up into the body mount pocket and secure using a pair of vise grips.




6. Using the new bracket as a guide, carefully drill (2) 5/16" holes into the frame rail. Special note: Make sure to hold the the cables running through the body mount bracket away from the drill and take special care not to damage the cables. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



Locate (4) 3/8" x 1" self threading bolts from hardware bag 10892NB. Working on the driver side, secure the front driver 3. Working on the driver side, remove the u-bolt nuts of the side bracket to the frame rail using the new 3/8" x 1" self threading bolts. Make sure to use thread locker or loctite. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.






Working on the driver side and using the front driver side bracket as a guide, carefully drill a 1/2 hole into the front and back side of the body mount pocket.









9. Locate (4) 1/2" x 1 1/4" bolts, (8) 7/16" USS flat washers and (4) 1/2" unitorque nuts from hardware bag 10892NB. Working on the driver side and using the new 1/2" hardware, secure the new front bracket to the previously drilled holes. Make sure to use thread locker or loctite and torque to **65 ft Ibs.** Repeat procedure on the passenger side.





10. Locate the new ladder bars. Locate the new poly bushings and sleeves from hardware bag 10892NB1. Install the new poly bushing and sleeves into each end of the new rear ladder bars. Special note: Make sure to use a lithium or moly base grease prior to installing the new bushings and sleeves into the ladder bars. This will help with the life of the bushings as well as prevent squeaking.

11. Locate (4) 1/2" x 3 1/2" bolts, (8) 7/16" USS flat washers and (4) 1/2" unitorque nuts from hardware bag 10892NB. Working on the driver side, install the new ladder bar to the front and rear bracket and secure using the new hardware. Do not tighten at this point. **Special note: The holes in the ladder bar will be installed towards the rear of the vehicle.** Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



12. Carefully remove the hydraulic floor jacks from under the vehicle and carefully lower the vehicle to the ground. Once the weight of the vehicle is on the ground move back to the $1/2^{\circ} \times 3 1/2^{\circ}$ bolts connecting the ladder bar to the new mounts and add some thread locker or loctite and torque to **65 ft lbs.**

Congratulations, installation complete!

Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension recommends that a complete re-torque is done on all bolts associated with this suspension system. It is the customers responsibility to make sure that a re-torque is performed on all hardware associated with this suspension system after the first 100 miles of installation. It is also the customers responsibility to do a complete re-torque after every 3000 miles or after every off road use. Neglect of following these steps could cause brackets to come loose and cause serious damage to the suspension system and to the vehicle.
