





POSITIONING SIDE RAILS

• EVENTLY PLACE THE SUPPLIED CLAMPS ALONG THE SIDE RAILS.

• ATTACH THE CLAMPS TO THE SIDE RAIL AND THE TRUCK BED RAILS DO NOT TIGHTEN CLAMPS UNTIL COVER IS PROPERLY FITTED.









• PUSH DOWN ON THE END OF THE COVER,


PULL ON EITHER SIDE OF THE LATCH CABLE TO UNLATCH THE COVER.











• MAKE SURE THE LOCKING CLIP ON BOTH SIDES ARE COMPLETELY INSERTED INTO THE CHANNEL ON THE SIDE RAILS TO AVOID END OF THE COVER BECOMING UNLATCHED.






• IF COVER DOESN'T STAY CLOSED AND YOU FIND THE LOCKING CLIP IS NOT FULLY INSERTED.





• TRY MOVING THE TENSION PLATE TOWARDS THE TAILGATE ON BOTH SIDES, ONE INCREMENT AT A TIME.





• MAKE SURE THE LOCKING CLIP ON BOTH SIDES ARE INSERTED INTO THE CHAN-NEL ON THE SIDE RAILS.
