

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove license plate.

 Carefully, remove the front facia plastic by first removing the screws and plastic push clips from the inner fender skirt. That will allow you to reach between fender skirt and plastic facia to release clips.

3. Un-clip and remove the plastic cover plate attached to the aluminum cross bar.



- 4. Remove the four fasteners from underneath the bumper.
- 5. Remove the six nuts securing the aluminum cross tube.
- 6. Un-clip ends of cross tube from behind plastic fascia.




- 7. Shift cross tube to one side and tilt outwards.
- 8. Remove the three nuts securing the aluminum frame extension on the side you tilted cross tube out from. *Retain nuts as you will be reusing them*.
- Remove extension. NOTE: With one extension removed, you should now be able to shift cross tube over and back towards vehicle, this will allow the tube to freely release from vehicle.
- 10. Once the cross tube is out completely, remove second aluminium frame extension, same way as the first.







12. Re-insert plastic nut (both sides) back into the inner fender well.



- 13. Remove the grill by removing the two screws toward the center and the two push/pull clips on top to the outside of grill and.
- 14. Grab the grill from the middle outer section and carefully pull straight out. **NOTE:** Be sure to not break the remaining grill tabs.



- 15. Remove the four screws (three at the top and one at the bottom).
- 16. Remove the six nuts from the cross bar (two in each corner and two in center).
- 17. Remove the four push/pull plastic clips.

NOTE: If vehicle is equipped with power steering there is one bolt that needs to be removed midway up on the latch.





18. Un-clip the wire harness from the cross bar and unplug at its connection.



19. Remove the side plastic shrouds on each side of the air conditioning/radiator, by removing the one push pull pin for each side.

NOTE: You will be trimming these after the mount is installed and reinstalling them into original location.

20. Before installing winch, carefully remove entire assembly, latch, crossbar and set aside (be careful of cables that will still be attached to vehicle).

TIP: Before installing the mount, we suggest to install the fairlead to mount, it will ease in installation.

21. Remove the O.E. bolt that holds the slip tube into vehicles frame (both sides).




A CAUTION

• Always use assistance when moving or lifting heavy parts.

- 22. With assistance, align the winch mount (A1) to stock frame rail.
- 23. Loosely, attach to frame rail. NOTE: Refer to exploded view on page 3.
 - a. Reinstall the three previously removed nuts.
 - b. Install provided hardware (B1, B3, B4, B2, B5).
- 24. Using slots in mount, center the mount to front of vehicle. Once centered, tighten hardware.
- 25. Slide the winch mount lower support brackets (A2) between the vehicles plastic and along side the winch mount.
- 26. Install bracket using original OE bolt and hardware supplied in this kit (B5, B2, B3 and B1).
- 27. Trim plastic as necessary. Tighten hardware at this time.



- 29. Position the winch with the winch facing you.
- 30. Have help holding the vehicles plastic and the winch power leads out of the way.
- 31. Install winch by lowering right side down through the opening where the hood latch was located and just to the left of the power steering cooler, *if equipped*.
- 32. Once inside the pocket, lower the other side of the winch into the carrier. **NOTE:** Make sure if installing synthetic rope winch you install the rope before installing the winch!

TIP: You may install the winch mounting nuts into winch first before lowering into its location. Use black electrical tape so nuts don't slide out will make installation a little easier.

- 33. Install winch.
- 34. Route your winch wires. *TIP: Use zip ties to keep your wires in a mechanically sound position.*
- 35. Re-install plastic shrouds (each side) of radiator. *HINT: You* will need cut shrouds to fit around new mount.
- 36. Reposition transmission cooler back in place and install bolts previously removed and tighten.
- 37. Reinstall cross bar, hood latch (You may need to trim or bend the bottom of hood latch to keep it from hitting the top of the winch.) and power steering cooler bolt, if equipped.
- 38. Plug in harness and re-clip to cross bar.





39. Install the pine tree clip (B12) in the center of your lower plastic. There should be a hole that lines up in the bottom rear of the winch carrier.



- 40. Reinstall your vehicles grill and license plate.
- 41. Tighten ALL hardware.
- 42. Your Semi hidden kit installation is complete.

MAINTENANCE / CARE

- 1. Inspect all parts on the winch, winch mount, and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
- 2. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, winch mount and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
- 3. Check all cables prior to use. Replace cables that look worn or frayed.
- 4. Check all moving or rotating parts. Remove debris that may inhibit the part from moving freely.
