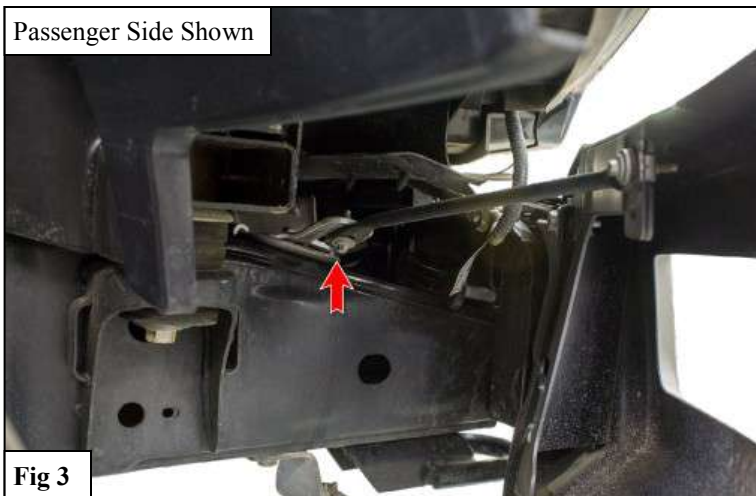
PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

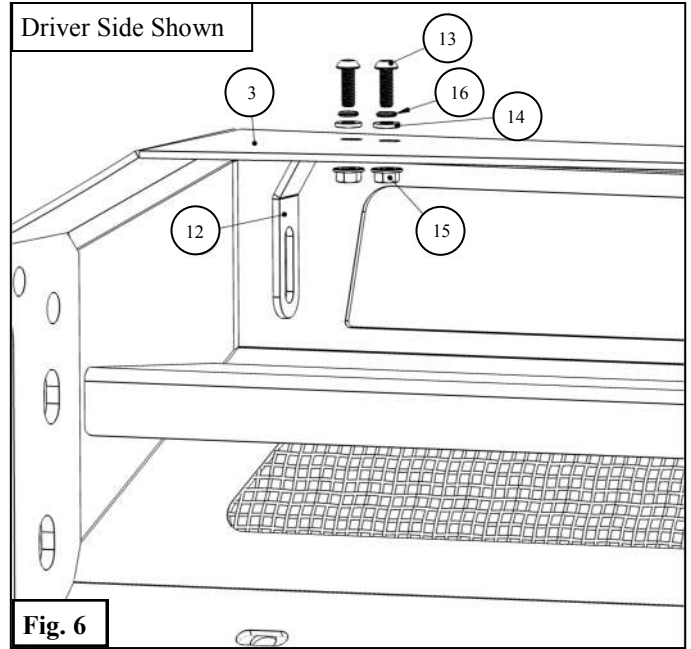
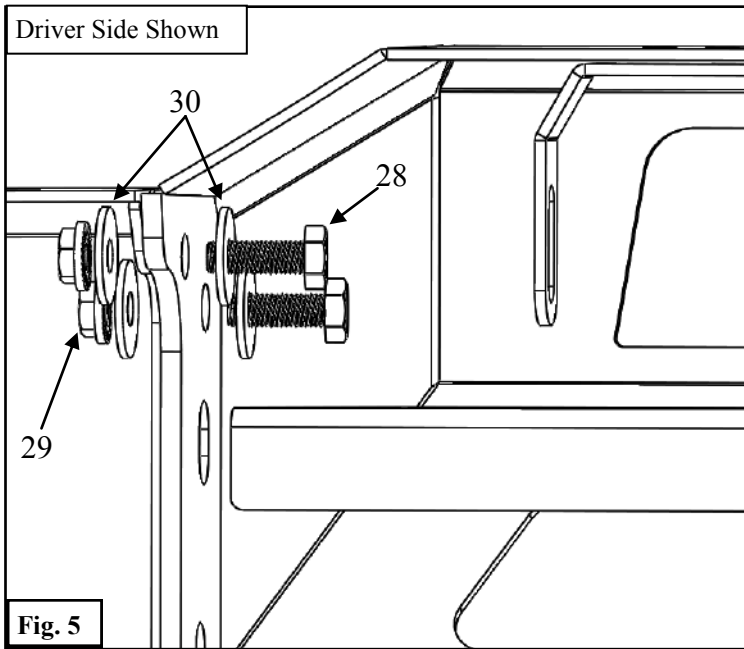
2. Carefully remove the plastic cover from the front of the OEM Bumper. See **Figure 1**.
3. Remove the 3 bolts on either side securing the Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC) module to the vehicle. Unplug the module and remove it. See **Figure 2**.



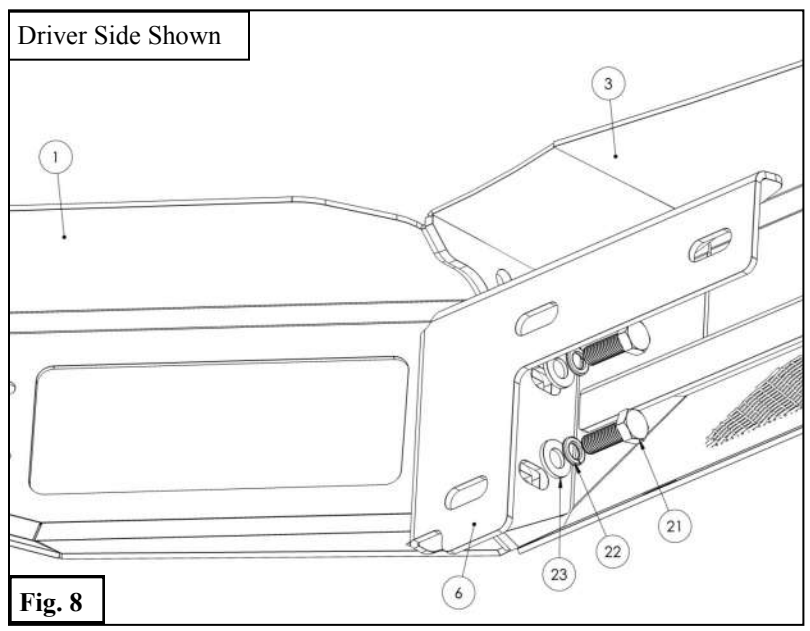
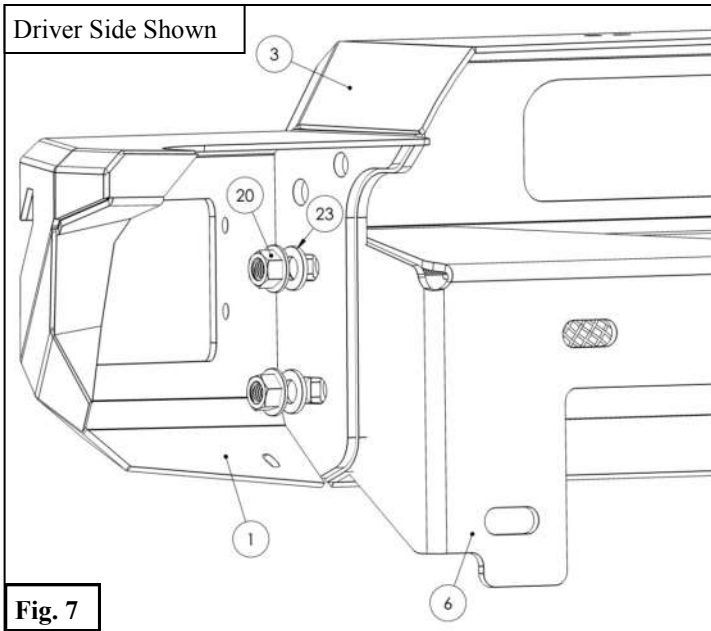
4. Remove the bolt fastening the bumper support to the vehicle. See **Figure 3**.
5. Remove the 3 nuts securing the bumper to the vehicle and remove the bumper. See **Figure 4**. *Note: There are plastic clips that need to be removed from the top of the bumper that hold a rubber strip. Do this while removing the bumper.*



6. Use the supplied M10 Hardware to attach each Side Pod Assembly (1,2) to the Center Section (3). See **Figure 5**.
7. Use the supplied M6 Hardware to attach the LED Brackets (12) to the center section. See **Figure 6**. *Note: If installing an LED Light Bar (sold separately), install it at this time.*

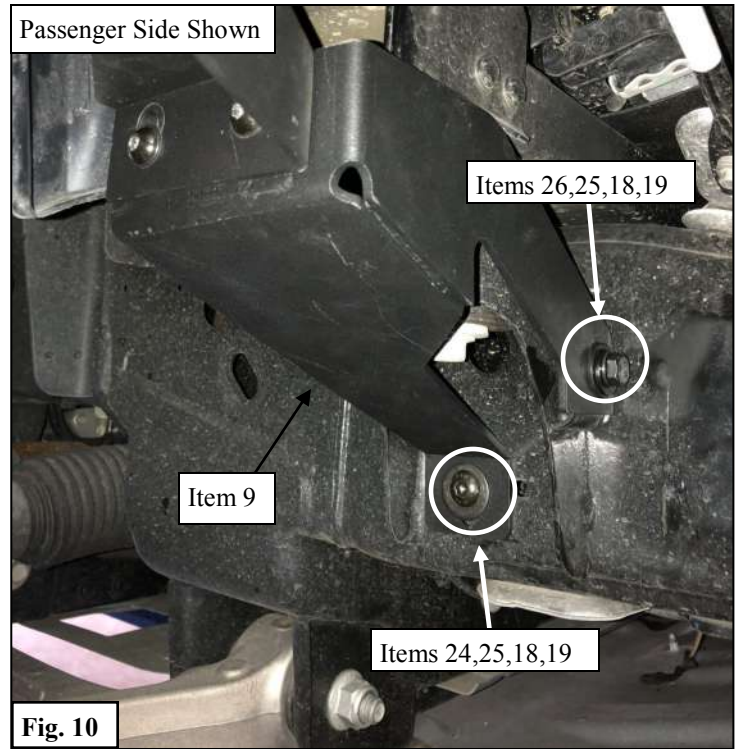
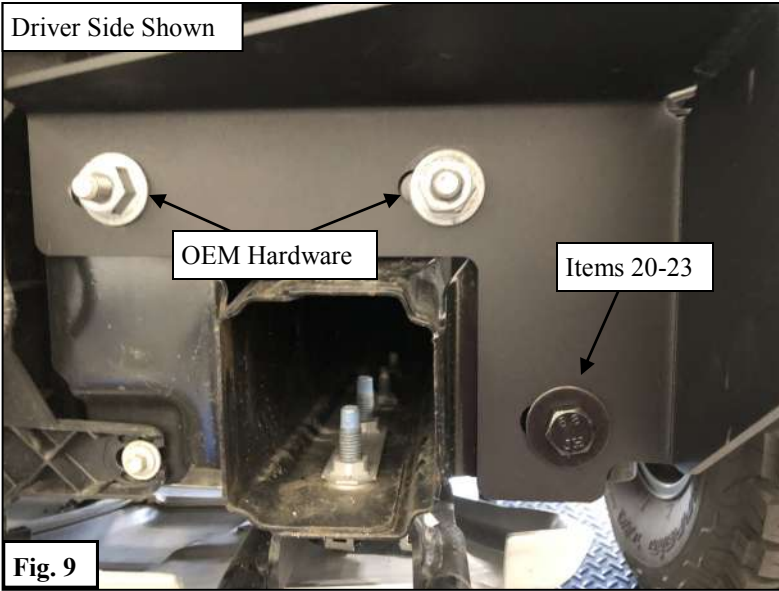


8. Use the supplied M12 Hardware to attach the Mounting Brackets (6,7) to the pre-assembled bumper. See **Figures 7 & 8**.

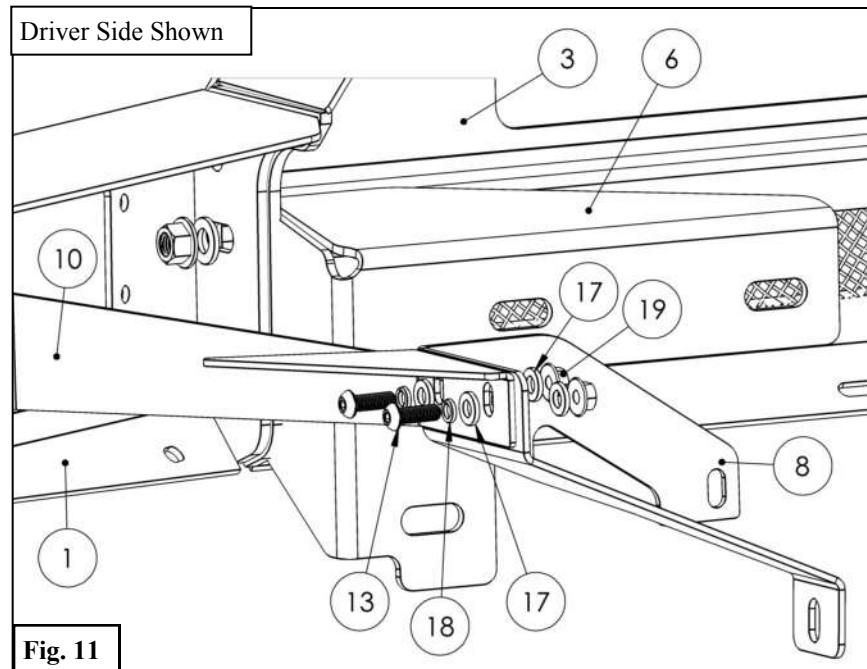


9. Use the OEM Hardware and supplied M12 Hardware to attach the pre-assembled bumper and mounting brackets to the vehicle. See **Figure 9**.

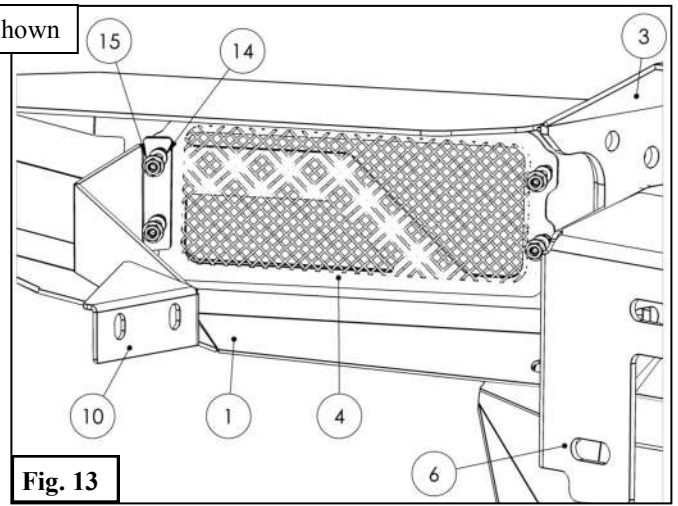
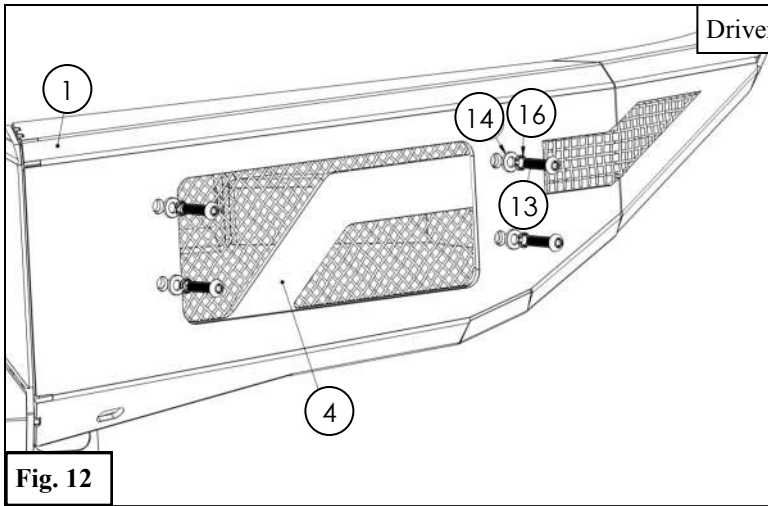
10. Use the supplied M8 Hardware to loosely attach the Support Brackets (8,9) to the vehicle. See **Figure 10**.



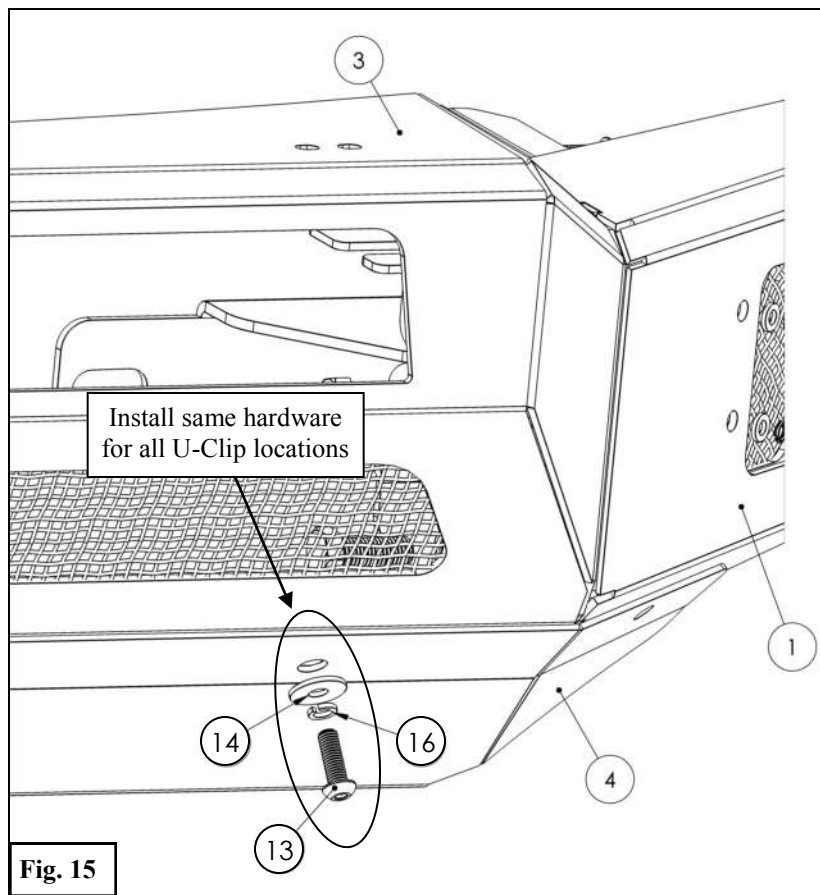
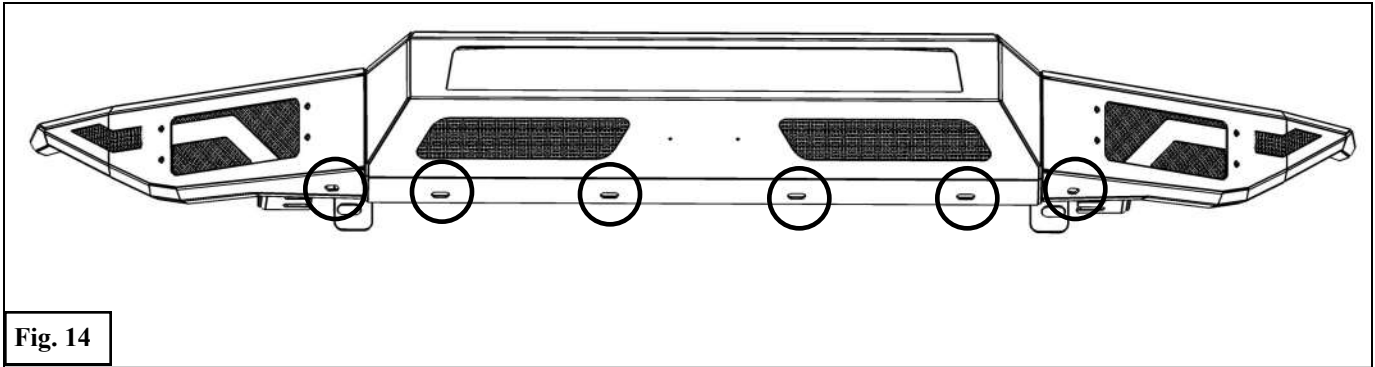
11. Use the supplied M8 Hardware to attach the Side Straps (10,11) to the Support Brackets (8,9). See **Figure 11**.



12. Attach the Mesh Side Covers (4) to the Bumper and Side Straps (10,11) using the supplied M6 Hardware. See **Figures 12 & 13.**



13. Attach the supplied M8 U-Clips (27) to the Bumper along the bottom edge as shown in **Figure 14**.
14. Attach the Skid Plate (4) to the U-Clips (27) using the supplied M8 Hardware. See **Figure 15**.
15. Align bumper as desired and torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M10 to 38 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs.
