
- 2. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the four bolts holding the grille in place. See **Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove 2 bolts attaching wheel well cover to filler panel. See Figure 3.




- 5. Pry off fenders to access the filler panel clips. See Figure 4.
- 6. Pry filler panel off removing any necessary bolts. See Figure 5.
- 7. Disconnect any electrical plugs and any bolts still attaching the grill to the vehicle. See Figure 6.
- 8. Pry remaining clips attaching the grill to the vehicle to remove the grille.



- 9. Remove 4 upper bumper bolts attaching the bumper to the frame and remove 2 bottom bolts attaching bumper arm to the frame. See Figure 7 & 8.
- 10. Remove Bumper.






 Remove OE bumper brackets and Aerodynamic Active Shutters. See Figure 9. Note: Removal of Aerodynamic Active shutters may cause Check Engine Light to turn on. Be sure to complete steps 23 to 26.



12. If equipped with parking assistance sensors, carefully remove from bumper along with wiring harness. Make sure to note orientation of sensors. This orientation has to be maintained during installation on Westin bumper.






PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION *If not installing sensors, install Hole Plugs into holes on bumper and proceed

15. Use the Sensor Tab (10) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (19-22)to install the sensors as shown in.




16. Make sure to maintain OEM sensor orientation.


Note: Handle sensors with care as they are fragile.



- 17. Using OEM hardware, fasten main brackets (Items 4-7) to frame of vehicle. See Figure 14.
- 18. Using M12 hardware items 13-15, fasten main brackets to inner brackets. See Figure 14.
- 19. Using M12 hardware items 13-15, fasten main brackets to preassembled bumper. See Figure 15.
- 19. Using M10 hardware items 16-18, fasten items 8 and 9 to main brackets. See Figure 15.
- 20. Using M8 hardware items 26-28, fasten items 8 and 9 to bumper sides See Figure 15.







21. Adjust bumper as needed and torque down all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft lbs, M8 to 18 ft lbs, M10 to 38 ft lbs, and M12 to 60 ft lbs.

22. Trim inner fender lining as necessary.


23. Once the bumper is aligned and tight, remove the two center bolts fastening the main brackets to the frame. See Figure 18.

24. Using M6 hardware items 23-25, pre assemble active shutters with brackets Items 31 and 32 as shown on Figure 18,19.

25. Using the hardware removed on step 23, fasten the assembly on to the main brackets as shown on Figure 18,19 and torque

M12 hardware to 60 ft lbs.

26. Connect the two cables from the active shutters.
