

- STEP 1. Remove the contents from box and check for damage. Verify all parts are present. Read instructions completely before beginning.
- STEP 2. Remove lower air dam from bumper by removing two push type fasteners from both sides of vehicle. Pull air dam forward to remove.
- STEP 3. From underneath front of vehicle, locate the body mount. Determine passenger and driver frame brackets. Attach frame brackets inside body mount channel with 3/8" fasteners as shown. Leave loose. **SEE FIGURE** 1.

NOTE: If vehicle is equipped with underbody shield package, it will be necessary to remove. If shield is to be reinstalled, both ends require trimming to fit around the brackets. Reinstall using 3/8' fasteners supplied.

- STEP 4. Attach hoop brackets to frame brackets using black zinc 3/8" fasteners as shown. **SEE FIGURE 1.**
- STEP 5. Attach Safari Bar to hoop brackets using 1/2" fasteners. Hand tighten.
- STEP 6. Center and level Safari Bar. Torque 1/2" fasteners to 65 FT.LBS. and 3/8" fasteners to 30 FT.LBS.

FINISH PROTECTION

Westin products have a high quality finish that must be cared for like any other exposed finish on the vehicle. Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax, (e.g. Pure Carnauba) on a regular basis. The use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental, as the compounds scratch the finish and open it to corrosion.
