


PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




2. Starting at the front of the driver side, use a 12mm socket to remove the two rocker panel bracket hex cap screws. Repeat same process for center and rear brackets. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference







- 3. Locate the Front Mounting Bracket (Item 2) and loosely install the bracket using supplied M8 hardware. Repeat this process for the center and rear mount brackets. See **Figure 3** for reference.
- 4. Once all of the mounting brackets are loosely mounted to the appropriate locations, loosely secure the Outlaw Nerf Step Bar to the mounting brackets using the supplied M10 hardware. See **Figure 4** for reference. See **Figure 5** for bracket orientation.





5. Align and adjust the step bars as needed. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 to 16 ft-lbs, M10 to 38 ft-lbs.


