
#### **PROCEDURE**

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




2. Loosely assemble the Anti-Rattle Bracket (3) to the main bracket (2) using the supplied M10 hardware. See Figure 1.




- 3. Slide the bracket assembly into the receiver hitch of your vehicle. Secure bracket using the receiver pin (not included). *Note:* Secure the bracket assembly as far in the hitch as possible. Three sets of holes have been provided for adjustment.
- 4. Loosely assemble the step bar (1) and the hitch bracket (2) using the supplied M10 Hardware. See Figure 2.

  Note: Four (4) M10 button head bolts, four (4) M10 tooth lock washers, and four (4) M10 flat washers are required for this step.





- 5. Adjust the step bar and bracket as needed and torque down all installed hardware: M10 to 40 ft-lbs.
- 6. Install the M12 bolt into one of the three holes on the Anti-Rattle bracket. Use the best hole for your application. Tighten the M12 bolt until the step bar (1) and hitch bracket (2) are adequately secure. **See Figure 3**.

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
