






#### PROCEDURE


 Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


- 2. Starting at the front mount location, locate (1) Front Mount Bracket and (1) Front Support Bracket. Loosely secure brackets, using: (4) M8 hex head cap screw, (1) M8 extruded u-nut, (4) M8 split lock washer, (3) M8 hex nut, (5) M8 flat washer, **See Figure 1. Note:** M8 extruded u-nut is only used if a threaded hole is not present (circled on **Figure 1**).
- For the rear mounting location, locate (1) Rear Mount Bracket and (1) Rear Support Bracket. Loosely secure brackets, using: (4) M8 hex head cap screw, (1) M8 extruded u-nut, (4) M8 split lock washer, (3) M8 hex nut, (5) M8 flat washer.
  Note: M8 extruded u-nut is only used if a threaded hole is not present. See Figure 2.





- 4. Mount the center brackets in the same orientation as the rear brackets.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-4 on the passenger side.
- 6. Locate (1) Step Bar Assembly and loosely secure it onto the previously installed brackets using the provided M10 hardware. **See Figure 3.** Install opposite side after.
- 7. See Figure 4 for visual bracket orientation.

8. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M8 hardware to 16 ft-lbs and M10 to 32 ft-lbs.



#### **Care Instructions**

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
