


IMPORTANT ALERT: GM uses a very strong thread-locking compound on all body bolts. Use of an air assisted impact ratchet can cause damage to the threads on factory body mount bolts and the internal nut assembly because of this thread locking compound.

We only recommend the use of hand tools to slowly remove and reinstall body mount bolts on all GM vehicles.


PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on the driver side, remove any rubber plugs located on the rocker panel at each mounting location. See **Figure 1**.







- 3. Locate (1) Mounting Bracket (Item 1) and loosely secure it to the rocker panel using the provided hardware: (2) M8 hex head bolt, (2) M8 flat washer, and (2) M8 lock washer. See **Figure 2.**
- 4. Repeat **Step 4** for the remaining bracket mounting location, see **Page 3** for bracket location.



- 5. Lay the running boards on top of the brackets.
- 6. Slide the M8 square head bolts (5) through slots on the bottom of the running board (excluding the center slot, three bolts per slot).
- 7. Loosely install the supplied M8 flat washers (3) and M8 nylon lock nuts (6). See **Figure 3**.
- 8. Align and adjust the running board as needed and fully tighten all hardware. Torque all M8 fasteners to 15-18 ft-lbs.
