


PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Starting on the driver side, remove the rubber plugs located on the rocker panel at each mounting location. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. For models with threaded holes: At each bracket mounting location on the rocker panel there should be a welded factory nut.




- 4. Locate (1) Mounting Bracket (Item 3) and loosely secure it to the rocker panel using the provided hardware: (2) M8 hex head bolt, (2) M8 flat washer, and (2) M8 lock washer. See **Figure 2**.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 for all remaining bracket mounting locations.







- 8. Secure the Plastic Bracket Covers (4) to the Mounting Brackets using the supplied M6 Hardware. See Figure 3.
- 9. Fasten step bars respectively to either side using the M8 hardware provided with the step bars. See Figures 4 & 5.
- 10. Align and adjust the step bars as needed and fully tighten all hardware. Torque all M6 fasteners to 5-7 ft-lbs and all M8 fasteners to 15-18 ft-lbs.
