





PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. For models with factory tow hooks: The driver side tow hook bolt must either be cut or the bumper must be removed to complete the Bull Bar installation.
- 3. For models with factory tow hooks: If removing bumper see Figures 1 and 2.
- 4. *For models with factory tow hooks:* Remove the tow hook bolts and the foam tow hook covers. Tow hooks cannot be reinstalled with application. **See Figures 3 and 4.**
- 5. For models without factory tow hooks: Trim the tow hook pockets in the front valance.














- 6. Locate (1) mount bracket (Item 2/3). Loosely install brackets using the provided M12 hardware. Repeat for other side. **See Figure 5.**
- 7. Reinstall bumper (if removed). Trim tow hook pockets as necessary.
- 8. With assistance loosely install the Ultimate Bull Bar Assembly (Item 1) onto the previously installed brackets. Loosely bolt bull bar to brackets using the provided 3/8" hardware. **See Figure 6.**
- 9. Align and adjust the bull bar and brackets as necessary then tighten and torque all fasteners as follows: M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs, 3/8" to 25-30 ft-lbs.











CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.

FASTENERS:

All Westin supplied fasteners must be utilized and installed in accordance with the installation instructions and apply torque to the specifications as defined. DOUBLE CHECK ALL FASTENERS BEFORE INITIAL USE, AND PERIODICALLY IN THE FUTURE TO ENSURE PROPER FUNCTION AND SAFETY.

DRILLING:

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle. FAILURE TO REVIEW AN AREA TO BE DRILLED MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR INJURY TO OTHERS AS WELL AS VEHICLE DAMAGE.

EYE PROTECTION:

ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES OR GOGGLES DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS TO AVOID PERSONAL INJURY.

MAXIMUM TOWING/CARRYING CAPACITY:
