

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION: 2007-08 FORD EDGE/LINCOLN MKX



- STEP 1. Remove the contents from box and check for damage. Verify all parts are present. Read instructions completely before beginning. NOTE: Westin does not recommend using closure strip for this application or light kit 27-6000.
 STEP 2. Determine passenger and driver brackets.
- STEP 3. Thread 3/8-16 x 1.25" hex head bolt through bridge weld nut, insert into outer hole, and use a plastic washer to hold in place. Insert J-bolt into inner hole and use a plastic washer to hold in place. **SEE FIGURE 1.**
- STEP 4. Attach front passenger side bracket to the previously assembled 3/8" bolt plate and "J" bolt using two 3/8" flat washers, 3/8" lock washers, and 3/8-16 hex nuts as shown. **SEE FIGURE 1.**
- STEP 5. Remove the two foremost factory bolts from the rear suspension bracket. Slide bracket into place and secure using factory bolts. **SEE FIGURE 2**
- STEP 6. Insert square head bolts as shown (2 per slot, 4 per board). SEE FIGURE 4.
- STEP 7. Attach step board to brackets as shown. SEE FIGURE 3. Make sure step board and brackets are properly aligned and tighten fasteners. Recommended torque values are 31 Ft. Lbs. for factory bolts, 26 Ft. Lbs. for 3/8" fasteners, and 10 Ft. Lbs. for 5/16" square head fasteners. NOTE: Brackets will not extend out perpendicular to vehicle. They will extend out at an angle.
- STEP 8. Repeat installation for drivers side.

FINISH PROTECTION

Westin products have a high quality finish that must be cared for like any other exposed finish on the vehicle. Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax, (e.g. Pure Carnauba) on a regular basis. The use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental, as the compounds scratch the finish and open it to corrosion.
