




## For desktop use:


- **1.** Attach the protective rubber feet to the mounting bracket as shown.
- **2.** Slide the scanner into the bracket, aligning the scanner's side holes with the holes in the bracket, and then screw the mounting knobs into the scanner.

Refer to your User's Guide for bracket mounting and vehicle installation.



- **1.** Connect the supplied adapter to the scanner's DC 13.8V jack.
- **2.** Plug the adapter into a standard household power socket.
- **3.** To disconnect, unplug the adapter from the power source first.

## PROGRAM FREQUENCIES

and you do not need to know anything about trunking systems, you only need to know what you want to monitor from the radioreference lists.
