


PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTICE BEFORE INSTALLATION.

- Disconnect negative battery terminal.
- 2. Note location of all wires and connections before any disassembly.
- Loosen cable nuts on old solenoid but do not remove nuts.
- 4. Remove wire and nut from one terminal and loosely attach to the new solenoid.
- 5. Unbolt old solenoid from mounting area and install new solenoid in same mounting position.
- Install second cable from old solenoid onto new unit.
- 7. Check cable locations for any interference and tighten cable nuts on new solenoid- Torque to vehicle manufactures specification.
- 8. Install starter solenoid energize wire on terminal marked "S". If the original solenoid has three terminals do not use the "I" terminal.
- 9. Reconnect negative battery terminal.
