



5 AMAZING NATIONAL PARKS FOR: CAMPING

Nothing is as memorable as camping in the breathtaking wilderness of America's national parks, where lifelong memories of sitting around the campfire, roasting marshmallows, and gazing at the gazillion stars above are forged. The memories are so strong, in fact, that even just the smell of burning wood will transport you back to the campsite where you last spent the night. Whether you are in a tent, a hammock, or sleeping out in the wilderness, camping in the national parks helps reconnect you with a way of life mostly forgotten in the daily hustle and bustle.

There are 59 national parks for you to find that one-of-a-kind bedroom under the stars. Here are the five best for incredible camping. Many of the parks require reservations, so be sure to check before you pack up the car and head out.

1 GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK

It should come as no surprise that the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, which straddles the North Carolina and Tennessee border, is a fantastic place to camp. It's the most-visited national park in America, and generations of Americans have learned to camp within the confines of this gorgeous East Coast gem. Camping here gets you in the middle of some of the oldest mountains in the world, while allowing you to explore nearly 100 species of native trees that call the Smokies home. The park has incredible hiking around every corner, world-class backpacking, and many historic and scenic wonders.

Great Smoky Mountains National Park has 10 well-developed campgrounds, perfect for families and those new to camping. They make the perfect basecamp if you want to explore the nearly 900 miles of trails in the Smokies, including sections of the Appalachian Trail. A stay at the Elkmont Campground near Gatlinburg gets you close to waterfalls, awesome hikes, and frequent bear sightings. For more seclusion, be sure to check out

the Cosby Campground, and hike up to the Mount Cammerer Fire Tower. The panoramic view will forever be etched in your mind, allowing you to return to this perfect moment each time you blink.

2 OLYMPIC NATIONAL PARK

You could spend a lifetime camping in Washington's Olympic National Park and not see it all. Considered to be three parks in one, the Pacific Northwest's crown jewel has a wide variety of options for campers. Only here are you forced to choose

among camping along a glacier-fed river in the rainforest, up on a windswept ridge with full panoramic views, or along the Pacific Coast next to or high above crashing waves. It's hard to choose a favorite!

If you are looking for solitude and awesomeness (outside of the breathtaking backcountry campsites) then check out the Graves Creek Campground in the Quinault Rainforest, or the always-gorgeous Deer Park Campground on Blue Mountain. If you want to watch the sunset from your tent, grab a campsite along the bluffs at Kalaloch Beach and fall in love with Olympic. There are no bad campgrounds here, only endless opportunities to reconnect with nature, your family, or yourself.

3 GLACIER NATIONAL PARK

It's said that if you haven't camped in Glacier National Park, you haven't camped at all. Once you spend a night, or seven, in this amazing national park, you'll agree. Glacier is where nature lovers

go to relax, and where campers flock to explore and take in the splendor of the Rocky Mountains. It's full of wildlife, and gives you immediate access to the stunning beauty of Montana. Glacier is where you need to go to answer the call of the wild.

Out on the "Backbone of America," you get to experience a little bit of everything from wildlife and glaciers to lakes, waterfalls and mountain peaks. You should also take the time to drive the park and enjoy the famous Going-to-the-sun Road. Camping at Glacier gets you into raw wilderness at any campground. However, your best bets for camping, wildlife watching, and access to incredible hikes are at the Many Glacier, Two Medicine, or Bowman Lake areas. This park is great for all, as numerous campgrounds have enough amenities to make nearly everyone happy.

4 CAPITOL REEF NATIONAL PARK

There is a romance in the Utah wilderness that is hard to replicate, and nearly impossible to fully comprehend, unless you are there in person. Located in the heart of Red Rock Country, Capitol Reef

National Park is one of the least-visited parks in Utah, making it an ideal camping destination. The park has access to miles of canyons, natural bridges, cliffs, and domes waiting to be explored. The park's main draws are the domes at Capitol Reef along the 100-mile Waterpocket Fold, and the amazingly iconic Entrada Sandstone temples of Cathedral Valley. Their beauty is unique and the stargazing is unparalleled.

The best way to camp here is to stay at one of the two primitive campsites, with your best bet being the Cathedral Valley Campground. For those wanting water and other basic amenities, there is one developed campground in the park. Fruita Campground has 71 sites in a desert oasis, surrounded by orchards of peach, cherry, and apple trees. Feel free to pick and eat their fruit while soaking in the western beauty of Utah.

5 ACADIA NATIONAL PARK

As the steady sounds of waves relax you into a deep slumber after a day of exploring, it's easy to fall in love with every aspect of this coastal national park. Acadia National Park has three easily accessible campgrounds and one remote island campground, giving you the perfect chance to have an amazing night along the coast of Maine. Best for watching sunrises and exploring miles of trails and tide pools, Acadia is an outdoor adventurer's dream location. Balancing beauty, wilderness, and accessibility, Acadia is perfect for family vacations, romantic getaways, and an escape from the doldrums of city life.

Stunning adventures can be had at both the Blackwoods and Seawall Campgrounds; but for true isolation and solitude, the Duck Harbor Campground is ideal. Located on a rugged island, camping here gives you access to the best trails and lets you sleep above the crashing seas and rocky shores that make Acadia world-famous.



5 INCREDIBLE NATIONAL PARKS FOR: CYCLING

From the seat of a bike, exploring America's national parks takes on a different view. As you pedal slowly through these protected lands, awareness of nature becomes strong, filling your nose with the smells of wilderness, while you feel the wind on your face. From cycling on the rim of a volcano and biking next to herds of bison to pedaling through the deserts of Utah and everything in between, these parks give cyclists of all levels amazing experiences in nature. It is a great way to bond with your family, your friends, or as a couple in the majesty of the great outdoors.

The views, trails, and roads are awesome, but what lingers are not the miles you put on your legs. Instead, biking in the parks creates lifelong memories and experiences, and offers a unique and amazing way to see the most beautiful regions in the country.

Here are five incredible national parks that are perfect for cyclists looking to explore the outdoors on two wheels:



1 CRATER LAKE NATIONAL PARK

Nowhere in the world can compare to biking at Crater Lake, which is exactly why you need to grab your bike and head out to Oregon's only national park. Biking Crater Lake gets you up close and personal with the geology of one of the largest volcanic craters in existence. Home to the most amazing blue water you will ever lay eyes on, Crater Lake's rim trail will have you drooling over the panoramic wonderland of America's deepest lake. From the rocky cliffs above, it's hard to imagine a more beautiful scene anywhere.

While Crater Lake offers incredible trails to hike, the best way to take in this natural wonder is by bike. The park has 33 miles of biking around the rim, with each mile somehow more stunning than the last. The ride showcases dozens of overlooks and views of the Pinnacles—towering, needle-like formations of rock. Be sure to cap off the ride with a quick off-bike run down to Cleetwood Cove, where you can catch a ferry to Wizard Island, a volcanic cinder cone with magical views.

2 YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

Where else can you have a safari adventure on a bike? Yellowstone National Park is like no other park in the national park system. It isn't the access to the park's stunning wilderness, rustic lodges, or even the impressive mountains that make it unique, but rather the overall environment that makes you feel like you are biking through a wildlife safari, with side stops at jaw-dropping geyser basins.

Riding through the park, you will encounter the overwhelming sulfur smells of geysers that momentarily distract you from the herds of bison and elk grazing in the grassy lands on and around either side of the paved bike path. With numerous roads, both paved and dirt, as well as a few trails to bike on, riding in the most iconic national park in the world will leave you in awe. Keep in mind that while animal encounters are minimal, riders do need to expect traffic jams from cars, bison, and maybe even bears. Follow all rules, and be extremely aware and safe.

3 CANYONLANDS NATIONAL PARK

If you have a mountain bike and haven't ridden in Canyonlands National Park, you are missing the chance to ride on some of the most impressive day and overnight biking routes in America's national parks.

Nestled in the rocky landscape of Utah, Canyonlands is one of the few national park locations where you can bike for an entire week and not repeat a road or trail. It has miles upon miles of trails to explore, each giving you views of the most stunning images this southern Utah park has to offer. Most popular is the incredibly gorgeous 100-mile White Rim Road, that grows more impressive with each monolithic tower and unfathomably gorgeous canyon wall you pass. Every trail here is worthwhile, so regardless of which route you choose, every rotation of your tires brings you closer to yet another memorable gem.

4 SHENANDOAH NATIONAL PARK

Less than a two-hour drive from D.C., Shenandoah National Park's Skyline Drive is the perfect biking route for those looking for beauty, elevation gain, and incredible views. This is a serious route, at 105 miles long, but its endless beauty makes the ride well worth the effort.

Biking Shenandoah is most stunning in the fall when the leaves erupt in an explosion of colors, making each turn a freshly painted, natural tapestry. For most, the highlight is getting on top of the hills, and seeing the beauty of the forests from above. However, don't forget to check out the handful of beautiful roadside waterfalls along the way up. For less-serious bikers, Shenandoah can be split up into smaller biking sections, giving riders of all abilities a chance to explore this often-overlooked park.

Bikers need to pay close attention while riding, as there are bears that occasionally wander into the road, and watch out for vehicles with drivers mesmerized by the beauty.

5 REDWOODS NATIONAL PARK

Dwarfed by centuries-old giants, biking through the Redwoods becomes otherworldly. Weaving your way through the ancient forests of the Redwoods, it's hard not to pretend you are in *Star Wars*, riding through the forests of Endor. As the towering trees rise above you, you'll be eye-to-eye with both the giant ferns and the massive trunks of these old-growth wonders. Biking in the Redwoods is a vacation experience of a lifetime; whether

you decide to head down to the coast, or hit up one of the trails leading to huge trees, you'll long to return here the second you leave. While seven bike trails are formally recognized, riding along Howland Hill Road or Newton B. Drury Scenic Parkway gives you the best reward for your effort. Each area also has a few hiking trails to explore, getting you directly into the groves of towering beauties. Few things last as long as the Redwoods, but the memories you'll make biking through the region have to come close.

5 OUTSTANDING NATIONAL PARKS FOR: PADDLING

There is something about being on the waters of America's national parks that nourishes the soul. On the water, the wilderness and your boat meld into one, letting you connect to nature in ways not possible in the city. So, it's no surprise that paddling in national parks is quickly gaining popularity, from sea to shining sea. From the sea stacks and crashing waves on both coasts, to marshes and lakes around the nation, the wonders of the waters are stunning millions of visitors each year. And why not? With each dip of the oar, new memories are created, and fresh images of the great outdoors replace unwanted stress. Paddling in the national parks is unique and special, and an activity you will want to repeat every weekend.

Here are five of the best National Parks from Maine to Washington for paddlers to unwind and experience nature by water:

1 ISLE ROYALE NATIONAL PARK

Isolated, rugged, and accessible only by boat, Isle Royale National Park gives unmatched access to the largest wilderness area in Michigan. Only open April to November, Isle Royale is the perfect paddling destination. Home to dozens of small lakes, wilderness-lined bays, small islands, and the waters of Lake Superior, the park provides miles of impressive waterways, perfect for experienced canoeists and kayakers.

Paddling next to the timeless, rocky outcroppings on the edges of the islands, it's easy to forget the details of the day-to-day, and truly enjoy the here and now. Stunning sunrises and sunsets highlight each day of exploration, and moose and rare wolf sightings make exploring Isle Royale full of adventure. If you are looking for a wild and rugged paddling trip, then this is the perfect spot.

2 ACADIA NATIONAL PARK

As you work your way across the swells of the Atlantic, darting in and out of harbors and bays, the majestic beauty of Maine's Acadia National Park comes alive. Watching seals, dolphins, whales, and other marine wildlife in the waters off the coast of Mount Desert Island, and smiling as shorebirds swoop overhead, you can't imagine a day on the water getting better than this.

Add to your experience by taking a short break from your kayak or canoe and exploring the nearby tide pools where troves of deep-sea treasures are sure to be found.

Whether you are with your family on easier routes, heading overnight with your significant other, or exploring solo, the beauty of nature and the stunning coastline will become the location of your daydreams for years to come.

3 EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK

As you slide your canoe or kayak into the murky waters of the Everglades, small ripples extend out from your boat, disturbing an otherwise still day in this swampy, marshy wonderland. Once overlooked by the kayaking community, Florida's Everglades National Park has now become a mecca of sorts for paddling enthusiasts. The third-largest national park in the lower 48, the Everglades offers endless possibilities for water exploration.

For lifelong memories of the majesty of the Everglades, paddle out of the Chokoloskee entrance and head toward Jewel Key and Kingston Key in the Ten Thousand Islands region. This region is known for being full of unique wildlife, but might be just as famous for its stunning sunsets on the Gulf of Mexico. Ten Thousand Islands is also great for shorter day trips and an introduction for kids or beginners to the waterways of the park.

4 OLYMPIC NATIONAL PARK

Paddling in Washington's Olympic National Park is considered by many to be the nirvana of sea kayaking. Passing between giant sea stacks and rain-forested hills abutting driftwood-filled beaches, Olympic's coastal wilderness paints a perfect portrait of Pacific Coast beauty. Home to the best natural coastal stretches on the West Coast, the park's sea kayaking is second to none. Where else

can you see seals, porpoises, and whales during the day, and then retreat to the dense rainforest or glaciated summits elsewhere in the park? Once you dip your paddle in that first time, you'll want to come back year after year.

If you are looking for calm paddling, Olympic also has incredible opportunities on numerous freshwater lakes around the Olympic Peninsula. Many paddlers will head to Lake Crescent near Port Angeles, but if you are looking for a unique experience, you should head to Lake Cushman or Lake Quinault for a truly amazing trip.

5 VOYAGEURS NATIONAL PARK

There are few places left in the world that give you the beauty, solitude, and isolation of Voyageurs National Park. Located along the Minnesota/Ontario border, Voyageurs is quietly becoming known as one of the best paddling locations in North America, with adventures for every level of kayaker or canoe enthusiast. Paddlers have access to hundreds of miles of pristine wilderness in the Land of 10,000 Lakes, which is nothing short of incredible.

There are more than 200 campsites, the majority of which are spread throughout the hundreds of miles of waterways. Voyageurs is perfect for those looking for remoteness and it's not unusual for you to have an island to yourself for a while. There's nothing better than spending a day watching wildlife from your boat, relaxing in wilderness wonder, and then camping on an isolated island beneath the stars.
