




YAKIMA LandingPad #9



If your vehicle has factory crossbars, remove them now.



REMOVE THE FOUR COVER-PLATES.

Use a flat tool to pry them off.



Access the small depressions on the inside edge of the plates.





LOCATE SCREW HOLES.

You may want to prepare holes by installing and removing screws until holes are free of debris.


FRONT OF CAR:
Use the two holes closest to the front of the vehicle.

REAR:
Use the two holes closest to the rear of the vehicle.

Remove the covers from the bases.





When the racks are not installed, use the covers to keep the bases free of debris.


COMBINE PADS TO BASES, INSTALL INTO TRACK.

- Match the shape of the base to the pad opening
- For Honda Element SC only, place spacer between pad and base. Match the shape of the spacer to the shape of the pad.
- Pads are labeled L and R to correspond to vehicle left and right, when sitting in the vehicle.
- Install screws and washers into correct holes (refer to Step 3).

Using wrench from Control Tower kit, tighten screws completely.



! Make sure bases, pads and spacers (if applicable) are fitting tightly into track.
