



— UNIVERSAL — **MightyMount**

Install Universal MightyMounts opening to the front of the vehicle.






(shown for accessory, Cobra bike carrier)

- Do not install KayakStackers (singlepost style), HullRaisers, or AnkleBiters. They will not work with this product.

Kit contains 4 of each piece of hardware (excluding the wrench).









FITTING PROCESS (Find the parts that fit your crossbars.)







Always use the **SHORT bolt with SMALL** bail — and **LONG bolt with LARGE** bail.





ATTACH THE THUMB-WHEEL:

If there is any looseness, or the mounts can slide on the bar, follow the fitting process again.




Repeat the fitting process until the MightyMount conforms to the size of your crossbars when the wheel is tightened.





REMOVE THE FITTED MOUNT FROM THE BAR.



- Assemble the remaining mounts, and carefully set them aside.
- Do not discard the unused parts (you may use them on future vehicles).




USE THE ACCESSORY CHART ON THE FOLLOWING PAGES.

- Determine which carriage bolt you will need, and whether adapter or spacer will be used.
- Some parts may replace your accessory hardware. Follow the diagrams in the chart.

ACCESSORY CHART


- 1. Find your accessory, and follow the diagram.
- 2. Install the spacer or the adapter depending on your accessory.






REMOVE THE UPPER PAD BEFORE CONTINUING.

- 5. Read warnings on final page!










COBRA WHEEL TRAY: Use the long carriage bolt from this kit.




REMOVE THE UPPER PAD BEFORE CONTINUING.

- 2. Secure the spacer and baseplate to the backbone using the HighRoller knob.
- 3. Reattach the pad.
- 4. Attach to crossbar, secure with bail and wheel.
- 5. Read warnings on final page!









SPACER POSITION:

If your factory bars are angled, and the spacer is not flat against the accessory, loosen the carriage bolt and rotate the spacer on the MightyMount.

You will need to remove the pad; be sure to replace it once the bolt is tightened.




HIGHROLLER WHEEL TRAY: Use the short carriage bolt and spacerfrom this kit.




BIKE WEIGHT LIMIT: MAXIMUM BIKE WEIGHT IS 30 LBS. (14 KG).

BASKET CASE (cargo):




REMOVE THE UPPER PAD BEFORE CONTINUING.

- 1. Insert the long carriage bolt through the wire-clip and basket loops, into the spacer and backbone.
- 2. Secure the spacer and basket to the backbone using the nut. Tighten with wrench.
- 3. Reattach the pad.
- 4. Attach to crossbar, secure with bail and wheel.
- 5. Read warnings on final page!




Be sure the bolts pass through the wire loops on the BOTTOM of the basket.




SPACER POSITIONING:

If your factory bars are angled, and the spacer is not flat against the accessory, loosen the carriage bolt and rotate the spacer on the MightyMount.

You will need to remove the pad, be sure to replace it once the bolt is tightened.





Basket will sit above bars as in option B and C (BasketCase instructions).



WEIGHT LIMITS

Follow the YAKIMA Fit List for your rack's weight limit.

DO NOT EXCEED THE WEIGHT LIMIT OF YOUR VEHICLE'S RACKS.

Maximum weight is 165 lbs. (75 kg) unless otherwise noted.

REMOVING YOUR ACCESSORY

Unscrew the wheels, carefully remove your acessory from the car.

RE-INSTALLING ACCESSORY

- Carefully tighten the thumb-wheels after reinstallation.
- FOLLOW SAFETY CHECKS IN ACCESSORY INSTRUCTIONS EVERY INSTALLATION.



ACCESSORY LOCKS CAN LOCK THE MOUNTS TO THE RACKS

(lock housings purchased separately)

- There must be adequate clearance for installing accessory locks.
- If the accessory lock housing comes in contact with the vehicle, even after loading the rack, do not install them.

TIE DOWN LONG LOADS.


Always tie down both ends of long loads to vehicle. Failure to do so can result in property damage, personal injury, or death.



REAR HATCH

Some longer loads may prevent the rear hatch from fully opening.

ALWAYS USE CAUTION WHEN OPENING YOUR HATCH.



ANTENNA

Antenna on the roof may need to be removed to prevent interference with long loads.

WARNING: BE SURE ALL HARDWARE IS SECURED ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS. ATTACHMENT HARDWARE CAN LOOSEN OVER TIME. CHECK BEFORE EACH USE, AND TIGHTEN IF NECESSARY.

MAINTENANCE

Use non-water soluble lubricant on screws. Use a soft cloth with water and mild detergent to clean plastic parts.

REMOVE ACCESSORY BEFORE ENTERING AN AUTOMATIC CAR WASH.
